Phonics: Letters and Sounds phase 5

Reading: individual reading books; information texts.

Big write every Thursday: descriptions, information text, invented myth, narrative text, questionnaires, letters.

Oral work: pair and group discussions, class games, perform in infant show, reading aloud.
