We introduced our weekly **Talk Topic for each class as a way of broadening children's vocabulary**, following the guidance "If children can't say it then they can't write it". We feel that this is having a negative effect on their use of language and so we would encourage families to spend as much time as possible talking together and the Talk Topic can also be

useful in this area. For the younger children you can discuss the Talk Topic in your own language if not everybody in the family feels comfortable speaking English.

We are still finding that too many children are arriving at school after 09.00.
